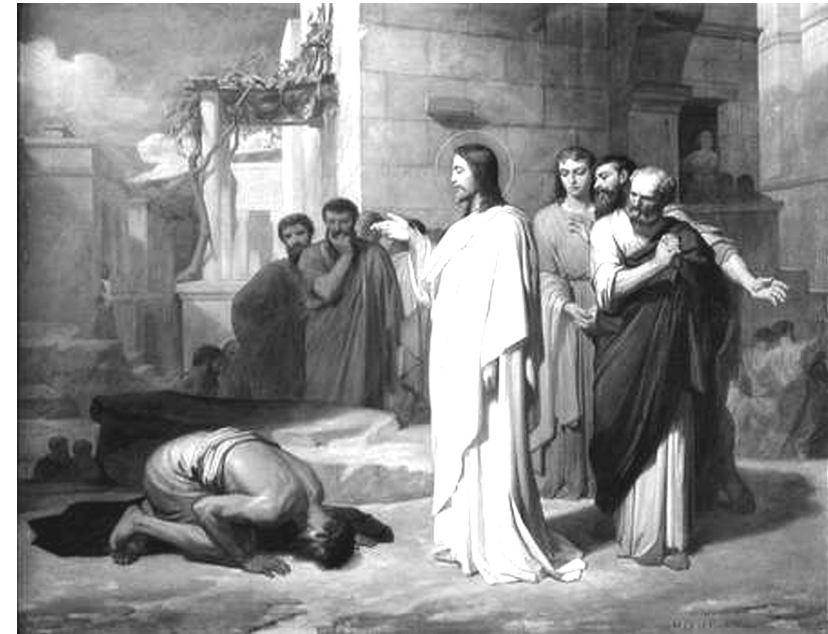

Here March 9**

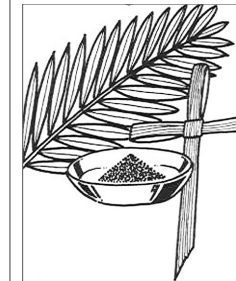
