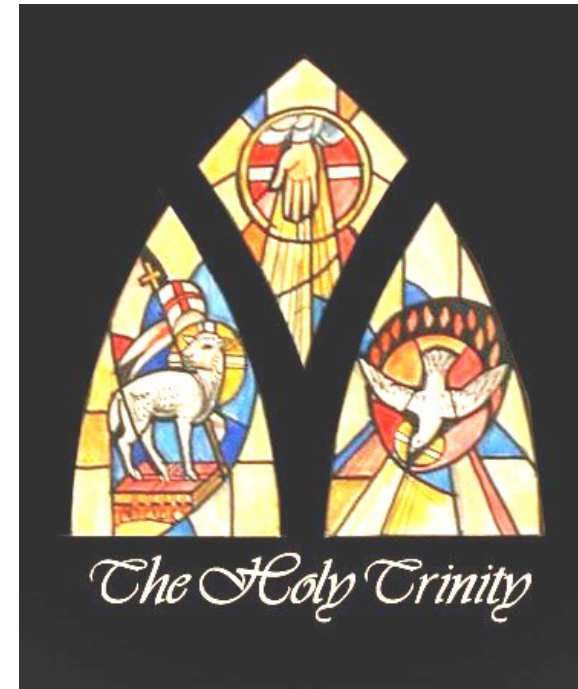

Fr. Jim will be out of town from June 7 to 11 in Warwick, RI in order to visit his Dad. He will not be available from that Monday - Friday.

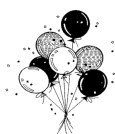
KOVAR Aids Virginians

In 1971 The Knights of Columbus in the Commonwealth of Virginia sought a means to accomplish the charitable goals of the order throughout Virginia. The result was the formation of a 501(C) (3) corporation dedicated to providing financial support to

organizations which support fellow Virginians with intellectual disabilities, regardless of race, creed or ethnic background. The organization was chartered as KOVAR. The primary fund-raising activity for KOVAR, became solicitation of contributions at public facilities by the individual KOC Councils and their families throughout Virginia.
