To provide a little inspiration during the current health crisis, I will devote the month of April to stories of the heroism of Virginia Catholics in past epidemics. Ann Behan Plume Herron was a wealthy Norfolk Catholic from a slave-owning family. When the rest of her relations fled the area during the 1855 yellow fever epidemic, she chose to stay behind to care for slaves stricken with the disease She also turned her home over to the Daughters of Charity, allowing them to use it as a hospital for victims of the epidemic.
