By the 1960s, the demographics of Virginia, and of the Catholic Church in Virginia, were changing. The Virginia church was growing, as many new parishes—especially in northern Virginia and Virginia Beach—opened to serve Northern Catholics who had moved South for work. These well-educated, middleclass, and suburban Catholics typically lacked the tight connection to the parish and sense of a shared history that had previously marked Virginia Catholicism. The diocese was growing numerically, but its sense of identity was weakening.

St. Vincent de Paul is the patron saint of our diocese, and we have been asked by the bishop to celebrate the 200th anni-


