As Bishop Knestout emphasized in his Roanoke homily on the 200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Diocese, our diocese has in many ways changed and in many ways remained the same in its 200 years of existence. We are still a small minority in a deeply Protestant state. Only 4% of the people living in the territory of our diocese are Catholic. Some Virginia counties—like Highland County—still remain without a Catholic church. At the same time—as the recent Octave of Service emphasized—the Catholics of our diocese do an incredible amount to provide education, food, and health care to all; comfort and assistance to prisoners; and outreach to migrants. We have an impact beyond our numbers, and we are a rich community with a shared history.

This is the final Sunday of the liturgical year, and my final note on our history. if you would like to read more, I recommend Fr. Gerald Fogarty's book *Commonwealth Catholicism: A History of the Catholic Church in Virginia*, where I discovered the events that I have related this year.
