Fr. Jim Away

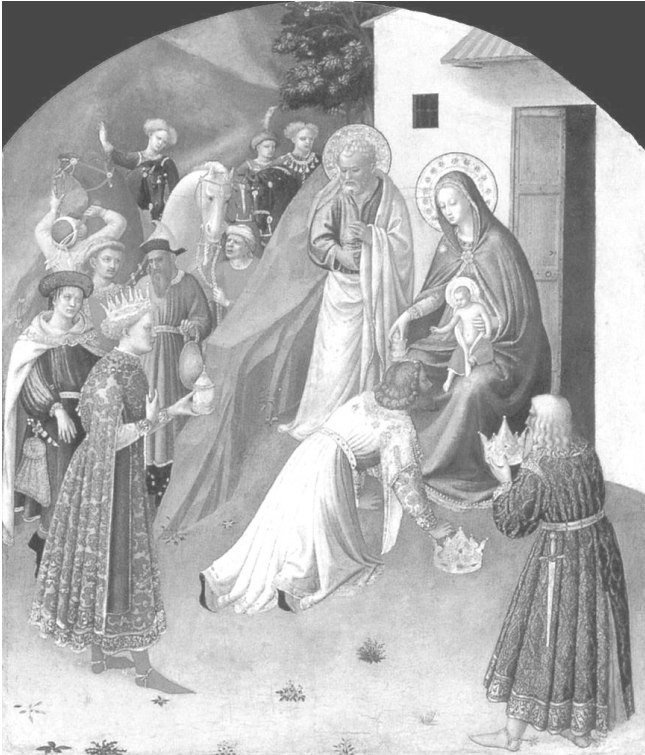
Fr. Jim will be away for two days on Monday, December 29 and Tuesday, December 30. There will be no masses on those days.

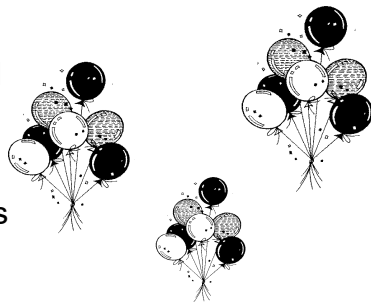
