What does zero tolerance mean in this case? One definition is, "refusal to accept criminal behavior, typically by strict and uncompromising application of the law". 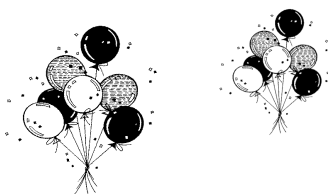
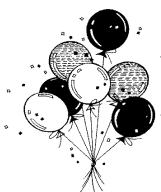
