The Diocese of Richmond requires each parish to comply with the Safe Environment regulation as a measure to prevent sexual abuse of children, young people, and our most vulnerable members. CEASA, the Committee for Education and Action on Sexual Abuse (formerly the Call-To-Action Committee), serves as the Safe Environment Committee for the parish of OLP. CEASA has been continually active with the OLP action plan, but because of the COVID-19 pandemic the committee has had limited contact with the people in our parish. We have created this part of the bulletin, called CEASA Chat, as a way of communicating what we are doing to eliminate sexual abuse and help our Holy Catholic Church heal the wounds of the victims and perpetrators. 




On the Cover This Week

This version of Christ's Resurrection, called *Noli me tangere* or *Touch Me Not*, is one of several by the Renaissance painter and Dominican Friar Fra Angelico. It is the image of a fresco, created between 1440 and 1441, at Cell 1 in the Convent of San Marco, in Florence. Fra Angelico was thought to paint like an angel but he was also known for living a holy life and caring for the poor. He was beatified in 1982 by Pope John Paul II.
