NEW(Part 1) If you have been sexually abused by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Church, you are strongly and vigorously encouraged to report the abuse. All sexual abuse is a crime with no Statute of Limitations in the Commonwealth of Virginia, especially involving a child. These acts of abuse are an abomination in the eyes of God.

Victims of these crimes often feel guilty, ashamed, or that it was somehow their fault. Nothing could be further from the truth. Victims are in no way to be blamed, but rather were targeted by a sexual predator who is solely responsible for what happened.

People who commit these atrocities must be held accountable for what they did. Be assured that Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church stands with you 100%, ready to offer whatever support is needed. The OLP website, under the CEASA tab, has all the necessary information for reporting these acts and bringing about justice for both the victim and the perpetrator.

KOVAR Aids Virginians

In 1971 The Knights of Columbus in the Commonwealth of Virginia sought a means to accomplish the charitable goals of the order throughout Virginia. The result was the formation of a 501(C) (3) corporation dedicated to providing financial support to organizations which support fellow Virginians with intellectual disabilities, regardless of race, creed or ethnic background. The organization was chartered as KOVAR. The primary fund-raising activity for KOVAR, became solicitation of contri-

butions at public facilities by the individual KOC Councils and their families throughout Virginia. Today, Brother Knights and their families host concerts, golf tournaments, Brunswick stew sales, 5K walk/runs and dinners to raise funds for KOVAR. In addition to the public solicitations, Virginia Knights have raised more than \$17 million through many programs and grants/ interest free home loans.
