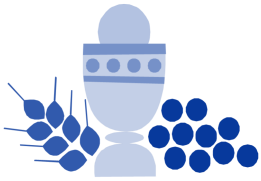

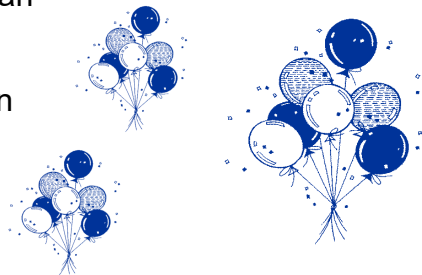

CEASA Chat

New - Diocesan Safe Environment Regulation. The Diocese of Richmond has recently published a revised Safe Environment Regulation dated April 2021. This document addresses the protection of children and vulnerable adults through ministry helping to ensure the diocese and all parishes are in full compliance with the Charter for the Protection of Children (aka the "Dallas Charter"). Reading this regulation can help individual Catholics, as well as parishes, to understand what we all can and should do to ensure our children are protected from sexual abuse. This regulation is available on Our Lady of Peace website under the CEASA/Safe environment tab or on the Diocese of Richmond website under Child Protection/Safe Environment Policies.
