



-NEW- Transparency and Accountability. The Church, like any other body, is always growing and trying to improve itself. Here is a brief accounting of what our Diocese has done over the last few years to improve its transparency and accountability. There was an independent audit of clergy files which lead to publishing the names of credibly accused clerics. The Bishop has strengthened polices including a new Code of Ethical Conduct and requiring all church personnel to complete VIRTUS training. Victims of Abuse are being supported through the Independent Reconciliation program and the Office of Safe Environment. More information about all this can be found on the diocesan website.
