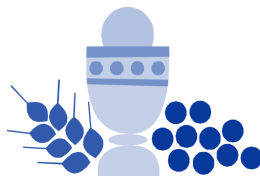

Mass, there will be morn-

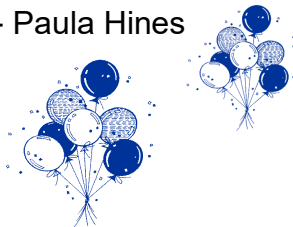
ing/evening prayer with
