Mass, there will be morn-

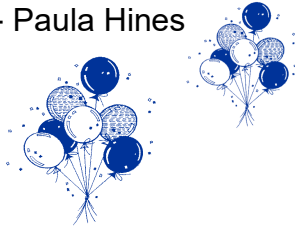
