On The Cover

On this week's bulletin cover is a picture of one of the Tiffany stained glass windows at Brown Memorial Presbyterian Church in Baltimore, Maryland. Louis Comfort Tiffany (February 18, 1848 – January 17, 1933) was an American artist and designer who worked in the decorative arts and is best known for his work in stained glass. *The Baptism of Christ* portrays Jesus with John the Baptist at the River Jordan. Mottled glass is used for the area around the water, with a layer of wavy glass over Christ's left foot to create the illusion of looking through water.

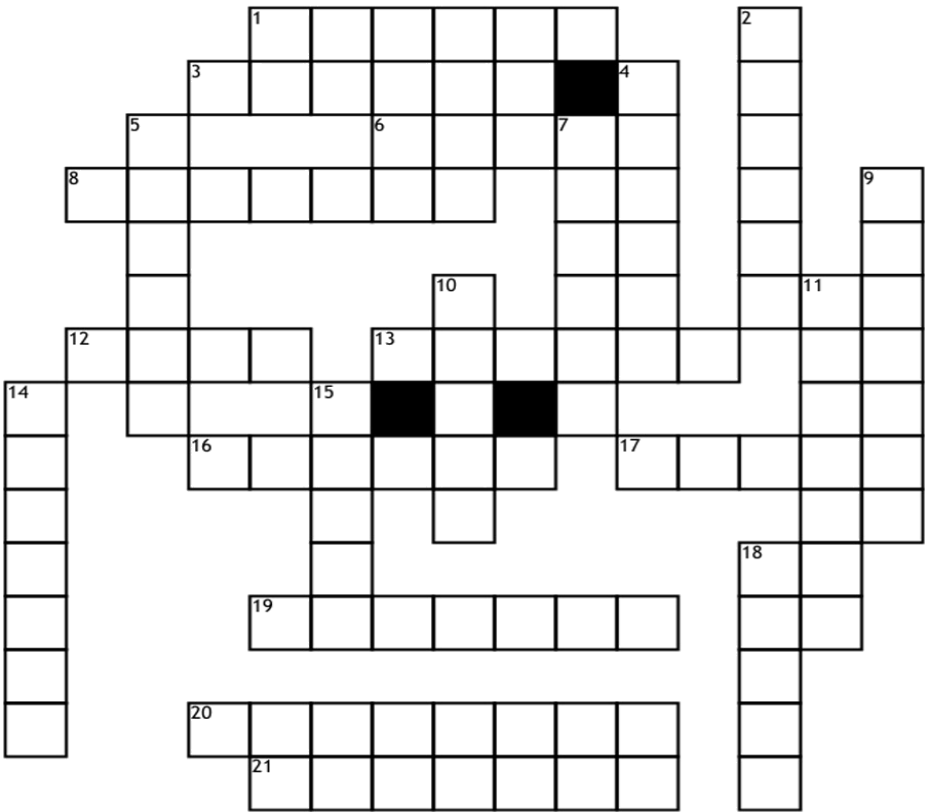
