

On Today's Cover

On the cover is the Medieval Russian Icon. The Trinitv. by Andrei Rubley. The subject is the Old Testament story in which Abraham receives three visitors as he camps by the oak of Mamre. Rublev puts the three gold-winged figures around a white table on which a golden chalice-like bowl contains a roasted lamb. The artist has given us many symbols in the icon. For example. The first angel is the first person of the Trinity - God the Father; the second, middle angel is God the Son; the third angel is God the Holy Spirit. All three angels have staffs in their hand as a symbol of their divine power. The most important symbol, however, is his composition. The painting is composed in a circle around the table, focusing the viewers' attention on the chalicebowl at the center—meant to remind us of an altar at Communion.


