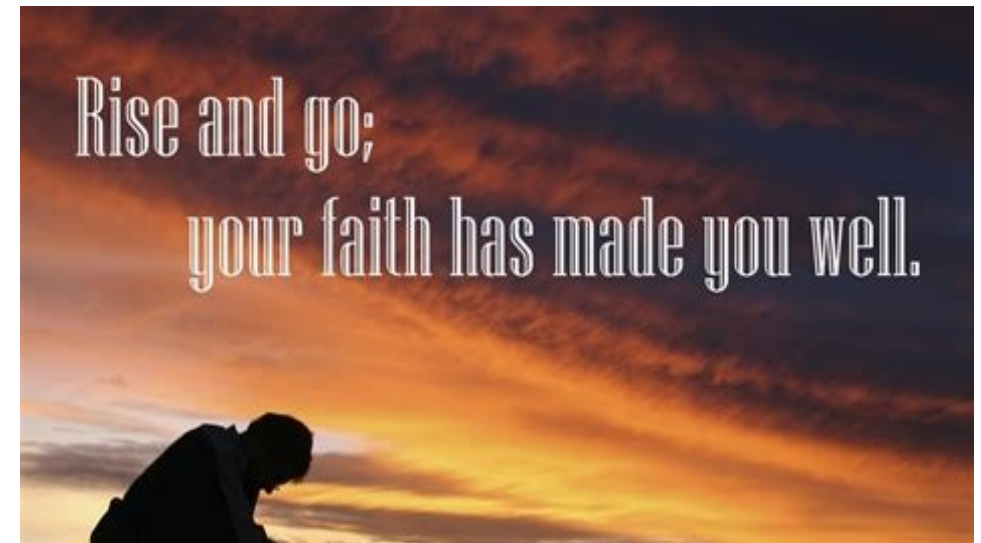
Our Lady of Peace Phone Tree

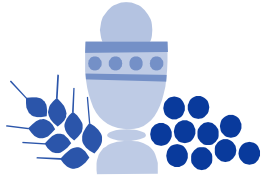

Our Justice & Peace Committee will be collecting hygiene items again this year to assist "Grace Inside" (Virginia's Prison Chaplain Service). This ministry is supported entirely via donations. A "Giving Tree" has been set up in the commons for your donations. We hope to have all donations ready by November 6, 2022. Fluvanna Correctional Center has approved the following donations and they are to be placed in a one gallon zip lock bag: one individually wrapped toothbrush in original container; one tube toothpaste, 6 oz, in original container; one deodorant stick, 2.6 oz. (no spray or roll-on); one bottle of shampoo, 15 oz. (no larger); one bottle of lotion 15 oz. (no larger) OR Christmas or Hanukkah cards and greeting cards for all occasions (please avoid cards with foil on card or envelope flap; stationery items (writing paper and envelopes sized 3 5/8 x 6 1/2" or 4 1/8 x 9 1/2'); wooden pencils (unsharpened).
