

# A PASTORAL MOMENT WITH FATHER JIM

Welcome to the Third Sundy of Advent or what we call Gaudete Sunday! Gaudete means "Joy" because as we get closer to Christmas, we have anticipatory joy or wat we sometimes call the "Christmas Spirit." The colors are rose. Mary, Jesus' mother, is called the Rose. Jesus is also called the Rose of Winter. One beautiful song is "Lo How A Rose E'er Blooming."

Some history: When I was a little boy Advent was like Lent. We could call it a "Mini Lent." (Remember Austin Powers and "Mini-Me?") The emphasis was on fasting and penance according to Grandma Galagher. It must have worked as she lived to be 100 years old! But after Vatican II, the emphasis was on joy and activism towards the poor. Penance is still a part as John The Baptist is still hanging out and calling us to change our lives.

What happened many years ago was that the bishops would travel around and ordain priests so the Christmas Masses would be covered. Traveling was stressful and the bishop would have to break his Advent fast. Of course, the newly ordained would have a party. So, the bishops declared that since he had to break his fast with the new priest, we should all take a break. Hence, Gaudete Sunday became a break for all of us. We could truly rejoice.

This Sunday in both of my parishes, we will celebrate also anointing of the sic. It used to be called "Extreme Unction" or "extreme anointing." But you won't have to be dying to receive it. It won's be "last rites." A list will be read at mass that is pretty inclusive.
